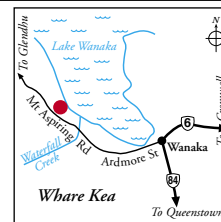

Set on the edge of Lake Wanaka, Whare Kea was designed by John Mayne and built in 1996 in contemporary-style featuring timber, steel and glass, maximising the lake views. The spacious rooms provide six guest bedrooms all with ensuite bathrooms including baths. Buffet and cooked breakfasts, as well as three-course dinners, are served in the large dining room overlooking Lake Wanaka, with views to the Southern Alps beyond. Whare Kea Lodge is fully licensed, and picnic lunches are also available on request. Set on farmland planted with native grasses and trees, Whare Kea is just seven kilometres from Wanaka township. Guests enjoy watersports in the lake during the hot summer season, and skiing or heli-skiing in the winter.
